

Programs:

Stanislaus County offers First Offender DUI Programs and Multiple Offender DUI Programs for individuals convicted of driving under the influence. Programs are offered in Modesto and Turlock, CA.

Per California's DUI laws, it's illegal to operate a motor vehicle with any of the following blood alcohol content (BAC) percentages:

0.08% or higher—21 years old or older operating a regular passenger vehicle.

0.04% or higher—operating a commercial vehicle.

0.01% or higher—younger than 21 years old.

All DUI convictions require drivers to complete a DUI program. The course length varies based on your BAC and any previous DUI convictions.

Your judge and DUI lawyer will inform you of your DUI program requirements.



For your appointment you will need to bring the following:

1. Payment of \$_____ Contact individual programs for accepted forms of payment (i.e. cash, check, credit card, money order & auto pay).
2. Picture ID Card.
3. Bring the following documents:
 - Current Court Referral
 - H-6 print out from DMV
 - or
 - The Admin Per Se, pink 30-day temporary driver's license provided to you by the arresting officer
4. No Drug or Alcohol use 24 hours prior to your appointment.

What to Expect:

State Licensed Driving Under the Influence programs provide education, group counseling and individual case management, and an individual substance use assessment.

The goal of the DUI Program is to encourage your exploration of the relationship between alcohol/drug use and the inherent risks involved, resulting in modified drinking/drug use in high-risk situations such as driving.

Program length is based upon Blood Alcohol Content and prior DUI Convictions.

12-Hour Education Only - BAC under .08%

3-Month First Offender - BAC .08% - .15%

6-Month First Offender - BAC .15% - 19%

9-Month First Offender - BAC .20% or greater

18-Month & 30-Month Multiple Offender - More than one DUI Conviction within 10 Years.

Important Information:

The State of California does NOT recognize any online DUI course and DMV will not grant or reinstate a Driver's License without official notice from a California licensed DUI Program. Failure to enroll and complete your DUI Program may result in a warrant for your arrest, additional penalties, and impact your driving privileges.
